If the rider is not a member prior to entering the class, the points collected in class will not count towards Year end high point. Points follow the member and can be earned on multiple horses. A new NCWHA member class has been added. *Novice member*, is defined an amateur member who has not won an end year NCWHA high point award. The same horse cannot be shown in more than one class and have points count. The same rider member may show in more than one class if he/she qualifies.

SHOE REGULATIONS AND LOCAL RULES:

All Breed - Classes are Designated for Non-Gaited Horses Only

OGB – Open Gaited Breed All Gaited Breeds Only

All Breed/OGB – All Horses May Participate

PP – Peruvian Paso Only

TWH – Tennessee Walking Horse Only

SSH – Spotted Saddle Horse Only

AOT – Amateur Owned and Trained

V – Versatility Classes

OT – Optional Tack – tack must be of the same discipline, no mixing of English and Western, with exception of Cavessons, which are allowed in ADP and CP Western Classes

All Day Pleasure Division: Max **MAXIMUM** shoe size on all four feet: **3/8" x 3/4"**, factory keg shoes. No caulks allowed.

All Breed: Open to all trotting breeds, no gaited horses

All Breed/OGB: Open to any horse

Country Pleasure: **MAXIMUM** shoe size on all four feet: **3/8" x 3/4"** factory keg shoes, whether flat heeled or with poured caulks, are allowed.

Lite Shod Division: **MAXIMUM** shoe size for all four feet: **3/8" x 3/4"**, caulks allowed.

Open Gaited Breed Division: Open to All Gaited Breeds Only **MAXIMUM** shoe size for all four feet: **1/2" x 1"**, caulks allowed

Trail Pleasure: **MAXIMUM** shoe size for all four feet: **3/8" x 3/4"**, caulks allowed

Tennessee Walking Horse Division: Open to **TWH Only MAXIMUM** shoe size for all four feet: **1/2" x 1"**, caulks allowed

Versatility Division: Please note the appropriate division for your horse

LIMIT HORSE OR RIDER - Limit Horse a horse that has not won 5 or more blue ribbons. Limit Rider a rider that has not won 5 or more blue ribbons.

BAREFOOT HORSE - This division is open for any horse that does not have steel or any metal material on its feet. All four hooves on horses shown in this division should not exhibit nail holes or any evidence that shoes have recently been removed. No exception. Nail holes are not allowed in this

division. The hoof on a Barefoot division horse should not exceed 5 inches in toe length and heel height no higher than 2.5 inches.

POLE BENDING/BARREL RACING – No canter classes, horses must not canter. If the horse breaks into a canter, a 5 second penalty per break will be added to the final time. All timed events must be ridden in a western saddle.

FIRST/SECOND YEAR GREEN AS GRASS - is open to horses who are competing in their first/second year of showing regardless of age, and is open to exhibitors who are competing in their first/second year of showing. **HORSE OF COLOR** - is open to horses who can be registered with a color registry.

CLASSIC HORSE - is open to horses who are 15 years old and over. **COME AS YOU ARE** - is open to exhibitors who may be part of the show team, as support, but are actively showing. Show clothes are not required, however boots and sleeved shirts are required. Professionals are not allowed to exhibit in this class.

ALL 3 GAIT PARTICIPANTS CLASSES MUST EXECUTE A CANTER – NO EXCEPTIONS

SHOW MANAGEMENT/COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL OR COMBINE CLASSES WITH LESS THAN 3 ENTRIES. EXHIBITORS WILL BE NOTIFIED 3 CLASSES IN ADVANCE OF ANY CHNGES.

PAYMENT AND SIGNED RELEASES MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO RECEIVING BACK NUMBER, NO EXCEPTIONS.

GOLDEN TICKET AWARDS The Judge will award 10 Golden Tickets to the Exhibitor/Horse combination of their choice, throughout the entire Show. If you receive a **Golden Ticket** you will be invited to Participate in the final Golden ticket class #134.

EXHIBITORS MAY NOT ENGAGE IN CONVERSATIONS WITH THE JUDGE. ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS ABOUT YOUR HORSE OR CLASS MAY BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE SHOW OFFICE, OR MAY BE DISCUSSED WITH THE JUDGE AFTER CLASS 134. ANY PERSON IN VIOLATION OF THIS WILL HAVE ALL POINTS REMOVED FOR YEAR END, AND ALL PRIZES REVOKED.

Stalls and Barn Assignments: The Show Manager handles stall assignments. All decisions are final. Please put in your stall needs with your entries. The management will try to accommodate everyone when possible.

Show Rules and Regulations:

1. We follow the Plantation Walking Horse Association rules. You can to go their website to read, copy or order.
2. All Judges Decisions are final
3. The DQP's and show management's decisions on an entry's soundness and fitness to be shown are final
4. Show management reserves the right to decline entry to any exhibitor and/or horse, and the right to order off the grounds any exhibitor and/or horse, without compensation.
5. Rancho Murieta, NCWHA and/or show management will not be liable for any accidents, damage, loss, injury, or COVID-19 related illness that may occur to an exhibitor, owner, trainer, agent, groom, individual or spectator sustained while at this horse show. This will be incorporated as a condition of entry or admittance to the show.

6. Any persons on Federal Disqualification CANNOT transport horses to this show and can only participate as a spectator. All NCWHA rules apply.
8. **THIS SHOW IS FOR SOUND HORSES ONLY. ANY LAME, OR SORE HORSE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM COMPETITION, NO QUESTIONS ASKED, AND WILL FORFEIT ALL SHOW FEES.**

7. **NO PLASTIC WRAP, HOOF BANDS, ACTION DEVICES, *LEG WRAPS, OR FULL BLINDERS WILL BE ALLOWED ON GROUNDS.**

8. Please clean up after yourself and your horse. Areas left messy after the show will be charged to the organization and subsequently you will be billed for whatever the facility charges (Minimum \$40), plus an additional billing fee of \$30. You must leave the facility in the same condition that you found it.

9. Horses may only be washed in designated wash racks areas only.

10. Absolutely **NO PARKING** on the roadways or access ways is allowed on the fair grounds. All trailers & vehicles shall be limited to designated parking areas so as not to block the fire lanes. A tow truck may be called if there are violations.

11. Horses are only allowed in the barn, warm up arena and in the main arena only.

12. No riding in the barns, on the lawns or on the roadways.

13. Dogs accompanying exhibitors and trainers must be managed at all times. Owners must clean up after their pet. If any complaints are filed, the pet will be required to be confined at all times.

14. No riding of motorcycles, bicycles, ATV's, or horses in the barns. Please observe the 10 MPH speed limit. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to drive any motorized vehicle

15. You must leave the facility in the same condition as you found it. Landscape materials used outside your barn area must be removed and the area swept clean. Vandalism, damage or displacement of Murieta Equestrian Center property or the property of any trainer, owner or exhibitors will result in a \$50.00 fine to all individuals involved in addition to any charges for damages.

16. Public drunkenness, aggressive, dangerous, or threatening behaviors toward any other person on the show grounds, show officials, show exhibitors, or guests **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED**, and the offending individual may be asked to leave the grounds and may be barred from additional participation in the ANY horse Show at the discretion of the NCWHA Board and/or officials from the Murieta Equestrian Center. In addition, law enforcement may be contacted in order to keep the peace and public safety for all individuals and animals. By attending the Mayfest Horse Show as an exhibitor, spectator, or guest, all individuals hereby agree to the rule and jurisdiction of the NCWHA, 2018 PHWA rule book, and Murieta Equestrian Center.

MEC COVID-19 MEC Trainer/Exhibitor Protocols & Expectations

General Facility Guidelines

- MEC will enforce 6ft social distancing throughout competition facilities, with placement of six-foot markers in all key waiting areas (Show Office, Café, Store, Vendors).
- All seating and bleachers have been removed or restricted to prevent/limit people gathering or sitting. All seating must maintain 6ft distancing.
- No spectators or visitors permitted on facility grounds.
- All VIP and social gatherings are prohibited during horse shows until social distancing guidelines and restrictions are removed.
- Guest occupancy limits for each area are clearly posted and must be observed.
- Equine/human capacity for schooling & exercise areas will be posted adjacent to each area. Holding areas and participant access will be limited to maintain social distancing.
- All feed and bedding orders completed online or by phone (916) 985-7334 or at murietaequestriancenter.com.

Trainers & Exhibitors are required to:

- Comply with facility and show management guidelines and protocols while on show grounds.
- Provide thermometers for staff and require daily monitoring.
- Regularly sanitize all equipment being handled including, but not limited to, stable doors, buckets, tack, grooming, feeding and stall cleaning materials after each use.
- Provide gloves and masks for staff and other personnel.
- Access to stabling areas must be restricted to grooms, trainers and essential personnel.
- All stabling areas, tack rooms and barn display/seating areas to comply with best practices and social distancing guidelines in effect at the competition.
- Strongly suggested to provide hand sanitizing stations in stabling areas.
- Use of gloves when using community wash racks and taps.

Should an individual test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of competing at MEC. Show management must be notified so that all appropriate organizations and individuals can be notified.

Exhibitors and trainers must assume responsibility for themselves and their staff while on show grounds. If anyone violates MEC rules and guidelines they will be asked to leave the facility.

In addition to these expectations, please carefully review and adhere to protocols and COVID-19 requirements established by horse show management.
